Welcome to Northern Spark—an all-night arts festival that lights up Minneapolis on the second Saturday of June.

Northern Spark is about connecting and mobilizing artists and communities around big ideas. This year and for the following 364 days until festival night on June 10, 2017, we're doing something big—exploring the interconnected, long-term consequences of climate change through art. Why? After the 2014 festival was nearly drowned out, we began thinking about climate instability in a very direct way. We looked to the many artists whose work engages climate issues in beautiful and daring ways. Knowing that we need facts to make good decisions, but that stories and culture motivate action, **Climate Chaos | Climate Rising** is a platform to turn a sense of overwhelm into concrete actions anchored in a realistic and hopeful map for the future.

Nourish. Barter for an ice pop from the future. Drink a cup of dandelion tea at dawn.




Perceive. Feel glaciers calving. Record your backyard perceptions in the mobile phenology trailer. Listen to researchers and respond with your body.
